

**SINGATHON WILL BE HELD AT THE CHRISTCHURCH TOWN HALL
ON WEDNESDAY 22 NOVEMBER 2006, FROM MIDDAY TO 8.00PM**

Q. What is a Singathon?

A. It is a singing show where you can get sponsored and participate in the singing at any part of the event, along with others on the stage and from the audience.

Q. What is its purpose?

A. To raise funds for the Cancer Society Tissue Bank, which conducts vitally important research into helping improve the treatment of cancers.

Q. Who picks the songs?

A. Each hour has a different theme with lead singers or a choir and they pick the songs. See the programme for theme details.

Q. How will we know what songs will be sung?

A. A list will be published in newspapers and on www.singathon.org.nz before the show and most of the songs are popular and well known.

Q. Will the words of the songs be displayed?

A. Yes, most songs' words will be displayed, although most will be well known.

Q. Can I attend if I don't want to sing?

A. Yes, for a gold coin donation you can attend at any time.

Q. Where will I be if I am singing?

A. Your choice, you can sing from your seated position or from the choir seats behind the stage, some people will be invited on stage but numbers will be limited.

Q. How do I get sponsorship to sing?

A. If you go to www.singathon.org.nz you will be able to print off a sponsorship form, you then collect pledges from your friends, family etc. Or you can set up your own page on www.fundraiseonline.co.nz to support Singathon

Q. Who receives the funds raised?

A. All funds raised go to the Cancer Society Tissue Bank appeal.

Q. Are any performers being paid?

A. No, everyone even the famous ones will be participating free of charge.

Q. Can I perform on my own?

A. Yes, some slots are available for auction. Check out Singathon on www.TradeMe.co.nz. Otherwise all songs will be sung by groups.
